**1<sup>st</sup> JUNE 1927**



Foundation of Wagner Hochdruck-Dampfturbinen AG, later known as Wahodag; development of particularly economical steam turbines and boilers for ships.

Takeover of Wahodag by MAN, corporate form changes to GmbH.

**SINCE 1953**



Construction and manufacture of main propulsion plants for naval ships. Later, construction, production and sale of oil burners for use in ship boilers and extending the oil burner range to include heating for industrial plants and residential buildings; development, production and sale of gas burners as a result of the rising significance of gas as a source of energy; manufacture of ship boilers and steam converters. Later, exclusive focus on the development, manufacture and sale of oil and gas burners. Initially, Wahodag is integrated with MAN Werk Hamburg and later continued as the „Department Brennerbau“.

Development and market launch of world-famous Raketensbrenner®, which is used in more than 1 million domestic radiators.

**1981**



The Raketensbrenner® is the first oil burner to be awarded the “Blue Angel” environmental label.

Integration into MAN B&W Diesel AG, Augsburg, the market leader in the area of marine diesel.

Manufacturer of heating systems for oil and gas; development and market launch of the EcoStar oil unit; taking over activities from EWFE Bremen, a pioneering company in the gas condensing sector: integration of a complete premium gas condensing product range.

# 1999



Third generation Raketenbrenner® receives the iF Ecology Design Award for first-class design together with first-class product quality and exceptional ecological properties.

# 2000



Integration of EWFE activities into MAN Heiztechnik GmbH.

# SINCE 2000



Continuous expansion of product range: gas condensing boilers, oil condensing units and flat and tube collectors for solar use; development of sales to include market presence in more than 35 countries.

# 1<sup>st</sup> OCTOBER 2005



Management buy-out by managing directors Markus Niedermayer and Juan-Carlos Gil-Söffker in cooperation with Haspa Beteiligungsgesellschaft für den Mittelstand mbH, Hamburg; change of corporate name to MHG Heiztechnik GmbH; MHG operates on the market as an independent and owner-managed company – supported by a financially strong partner with long-term focus.

The newly developed gas condensing boiler ProCon HT 150/225 is awarded the iF product design award 2006 for its attractive technical design.

# MARCH 2006



Introduction of the premium pellet heating boiler LinoStar; the company is planning to keep expanding its renewable energy product range.
